DINOSAUR NAT'L MONUMENT & FLAMING GORGE RESERVOIR RIDE

AUGUST 28—30, 2010



Join your friends for a 3 day ride to visit the Dinosaur National Monument and Flaming Gorge Reservoir.

We depart 8:30 on Saturday from the Great Indoors, Park Meadows Mall. We will stop at Dinosaur National Monument that afternoon and visit an area where some of the largest land creatures of all time lived and died. The main exhibit wall is closed, but fossils can be seen on a short 1/2 mile hike from the temporary visitors center. We can also view rock art and captivating scenery before going on to Vernal, UT for the evening.

Sunday, we'll circle Flaming Gorge Reservoir, a huge 91 miles long feature. This reservoir and its 502 foot dam, impounds the Green River and has many petro glyphs and artifacts from its early history. We'll return to Vernal Sunday evening

Monday, we'll take a variation of Saturday's ride back to Denver. Mileage estimate for day 1 is 339 miles, day 2 is 230 miles and 321 miles for day 3.
