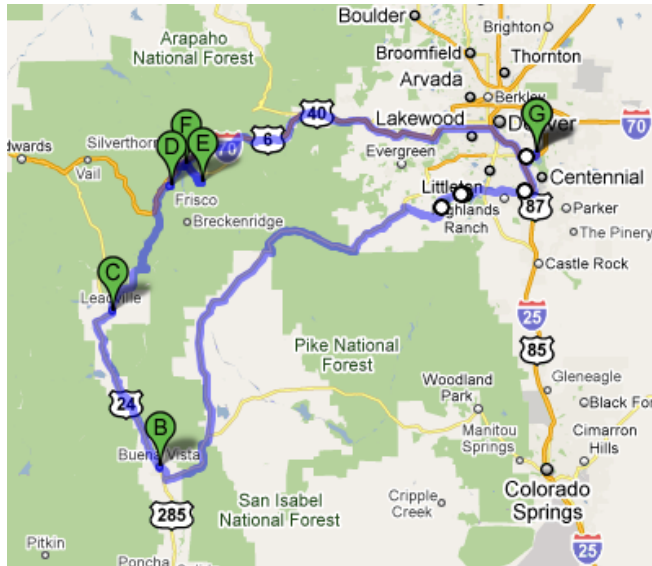


Leadville History Ride

The Leadville History Ride will depart from BMW of Denver at 8:30 AM on Saturday July 31st for Leadville by way of C-470, Dear Creek Canyon Road, Hwy-285 and Hwy-24 into the western entrance to Leadville. We will have lunch and tour



a Leadville history museum before catching the 2 PM Leadville Colorado & Southern Railroad ride. The Leadville, Colorado & Southern Railroad is a scenic mountain train trip that lasts two and one-half hours. The round-trip leaves from and returns to the old restored 1894 depot where there is plenty of free parking. Be sure to call 1-866-386-3936 at least two weeks ahead of time to reserve your train ticket for the July 31st 2 PM departure or purchase on-line at (www.leadville-train.com). Tickets are \$32.50 each.

After the train ride we will proceed to Cap Witzler's house located at 73 Mountain Bluebell Road in Keystone (970-513-7300) for burgers/hot dogs and refreshments by way of Highway 91 to the Copper Mountain I-70 intersection. At Frisco we will exit I-70 and follow the Dillon Dam Road to Keystone and Cap's house.

Those choosing to stay the night in the Keystone area after Cap's cook-out can contact the Quality Inn at 970-513-1222 for a room (Confirmation #1153512). Six rooms are



being held under my name at \$85/night. Make your motel reservations earliest possible date by July 20th for the discounted rate. The Quality Inn is located at 530 Silverthorne Lane, Silverthorne, CO, (970-513-1222).

Riders not staying the night in Silverthorne or attending Cap's cook-out can return to Denver on I-70 immediately after the train ride.
